

THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE LIBERAL CITY COMMISSION

March 7, 2013

The special meeting of the Liberal City Commission was held at 4:00 p.m. in the Commission Chambers located at 325 North Washington on Thursday, March 7, 2013.

Commissioners Present: Mayor Tim Long, Vice Mayor Joe Denoyer, Larry Koochel and Janet Willimon.

City Staff Present: City Manager Mark Hall, Public Works Director Joe Sealey, Finance Director Chris Ford, City Clerk Debbie Giskie and Recreation Director William Weber.

Mayor Long declared the meeting called to order and City Clerk Giskie read the roll call declaring all members present.

1. Pool.

- City Manager Hall reported Mr. Sealey would provide more details on the repairs and explained we would like to proceed because of the upcoming season.
- Public Works Director Sealey advised City staff contacted several pool consultants found they were unable to give us a definite cost estimate price because of the uncertainty of what using found underneath the floor of the pool ranging from \$300,00 to \$500,000.
- Mr. Sealey noted that J-A-G has agreed to do the concrete removal for time and materials. He further advised he could complete the removal within two weeks and would start on Monday if approved tonight.

Following further discussion, Vice Mayor Denoyer moved to authorize work to start as soon as possible on the removal of the concrete on the bottom of the pool, as presented. Commissioner Harrison seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned by motion of Vice Mayor Denoyer.
